- **Torquay Food Aid** Thank you to everyone who donated goods in the last few months.
- **Parish Lunch 15 August** We are planning a day to celebrate the launch of Norma's 'A History of The Surf Coast Anglican Churches', and to thank a number of others for their work in the parish, as we toward St Luke's 75th Anniversary in August 2022.
- We will have a combined service at 10am at St Luke's, morning tea at the hall (free), then roast lunch at Kithbrook Park centre 12:30-3:30pm for \$30 per head and drinks for purchase from the bar.
- These will be ticket events, and there will be guests from outside the parish invited. You will need to book. There will be 86 tickets for the service and morning tea, 150 for the lunch. If you attend either part of the day, you will be participating in what happens in some format.
- During the service we will remember the history of our parish and it's people, and take time to thank those who have more recently been contributing in various ways, particularly those who have or are changing roles or relocating. We will pray a blessing on the parish for the years ahead.
- Lunch will begin at 12:30pm at Kithbrook Park. Between courses at *A History of Surf Coast Anglican Churches* will be formally launched.
- Spiral bound editions of the book will be available at morning tea to view along with other historical material including photos. If you have items of interest for this display, please consider loaning them to the Parish for the day. Invitations will be sent soon, books will be available to order in published form on the day and available at a date yet to be determined. COVID updates - Masks mandatory indoors, distancing outdoors. The 2sqm rule applies. 30 in St Luke's church, 10 in the foyer and meeting room, 72 in the hall. Anglesea with 24 in church, 20 in foyer. BUT WE MUST ALL CHECK IN DIGITALLY - by phone or the iPad at church.

15 extras can be in the home, making craft and Torquay home group possible. Apart from church services other meetings can take place in our facilities. The 2sqm rule on the signs applies. For the Op Shop if there is a COVID check-in marshal, a 2sqm rule applies. Weddings & funerals can have a total of 300 people plus those required to conduct the service with a 4sqm rule or half the number on the sign.

If you are unwell and showing symptoms of COVID, which are like symptoms of a cold, get tested and isolate while waiting for the results. Results are returned often in 24hours. Please get immunised for both COVID and the flu.
